Beginnings

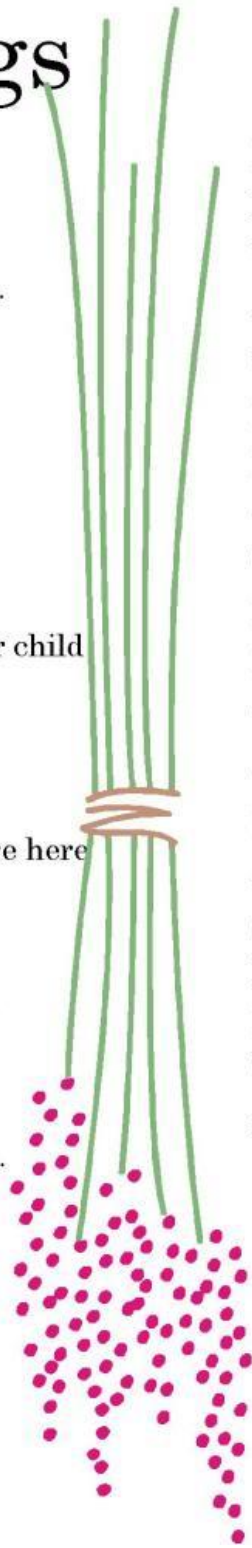
A new baby is on the way.
