Because I'm trying to protect YOU from my tears.

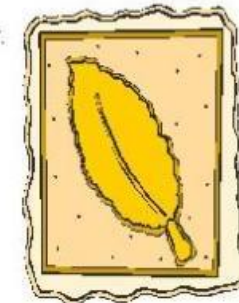
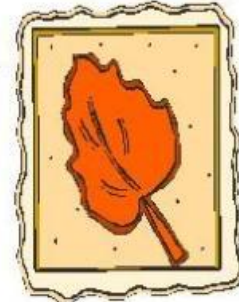
Then we both hurt me, because my pain is held inside, a shield against our closeness

And you, because we are suddenly distant.

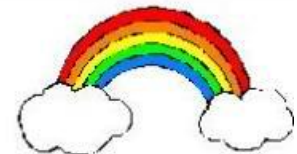
So please, take my hand and see me through my tears....

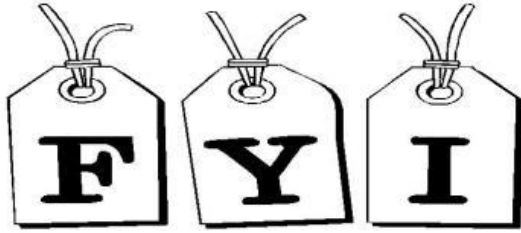
