Just as the children of earth will do.

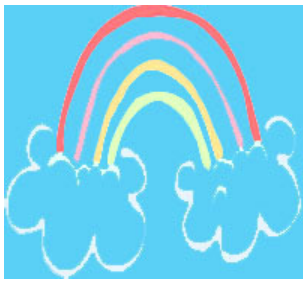
Thank you Mr. Hallmark, I know you'll do your

eternity.

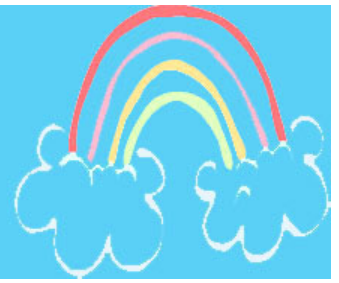
